

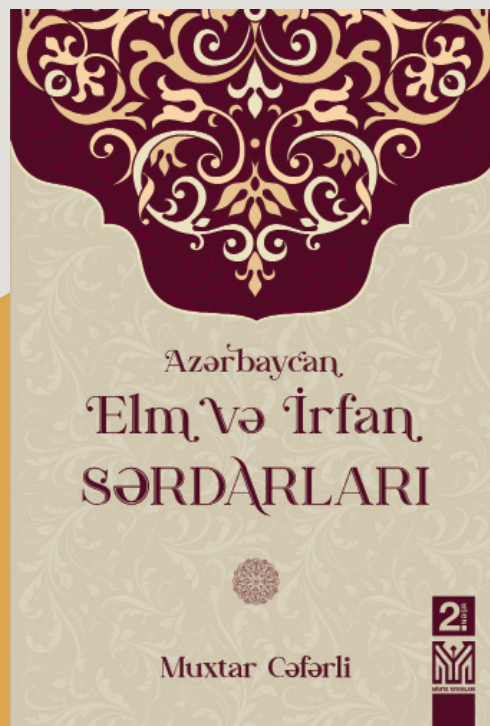

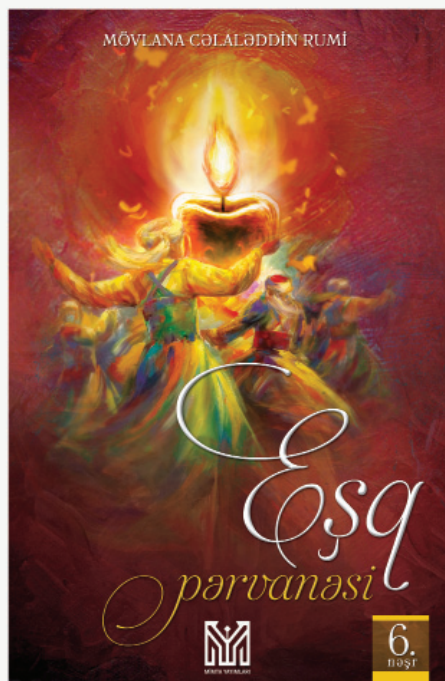
Science and wisdom leaders of Azerbaijan MUKHTAR JAFARLI

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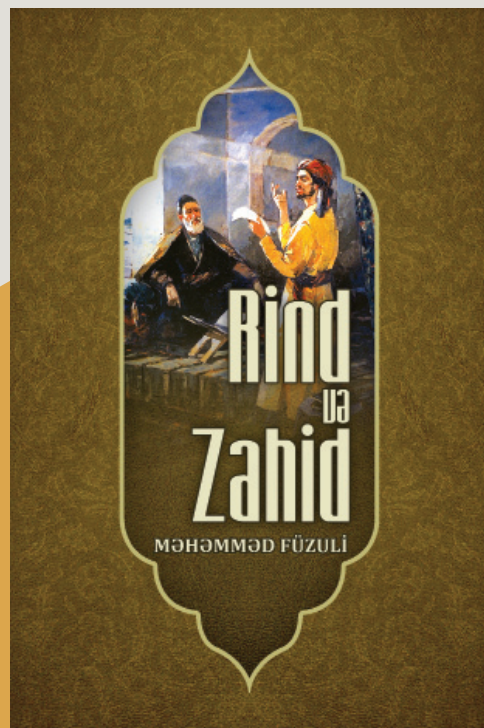

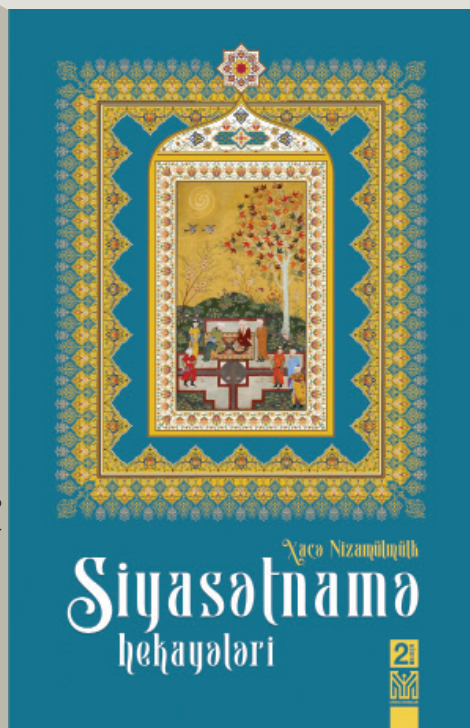

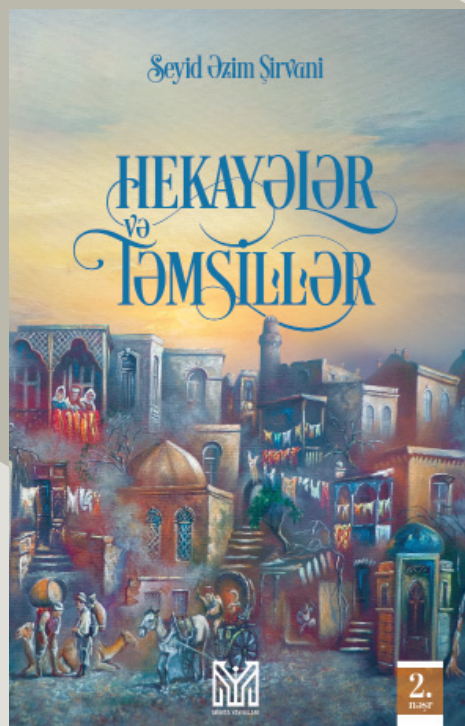
"Stories and fables" SEYID AZIM SHIRVANI

"Stories from the books of politics" ("The Seyāsət-nāmeh") MULLAH NIZAM AL-MULK

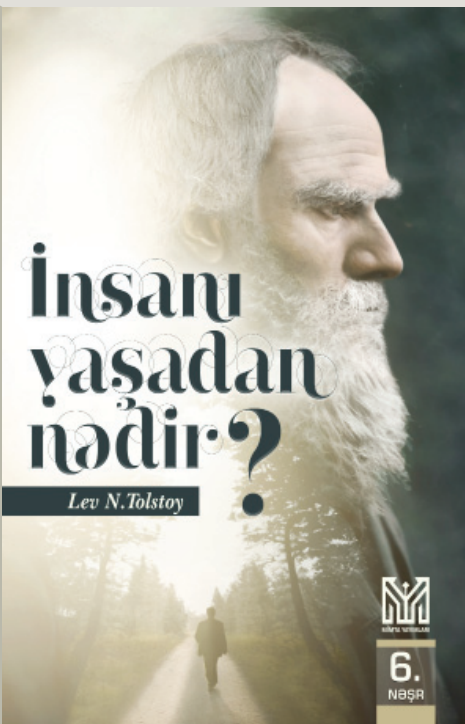

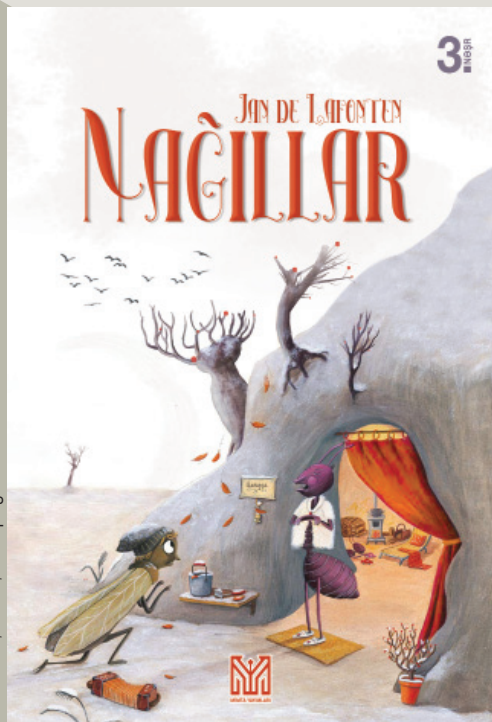
**"Mount HUN"

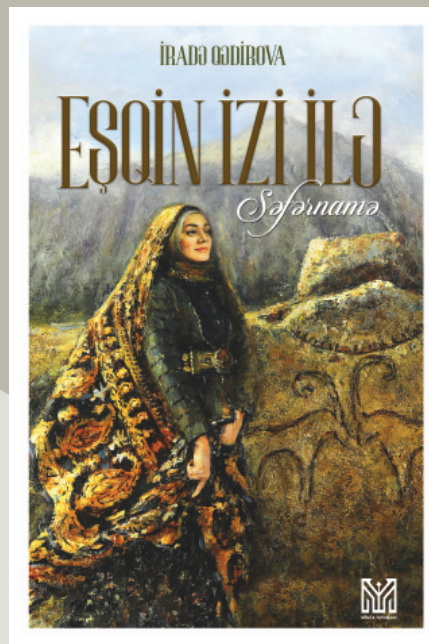
"The Hyperboloid of Engineer Garin" ALEKSEY TOLSTOY

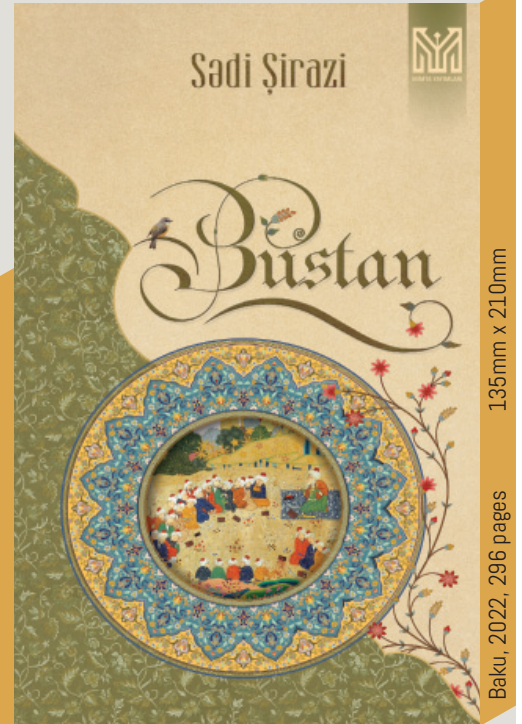

"Bustan" SADI SHIRAZI

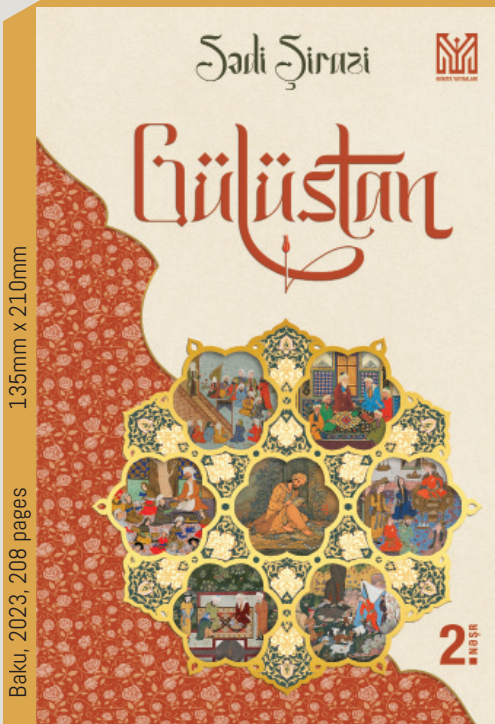

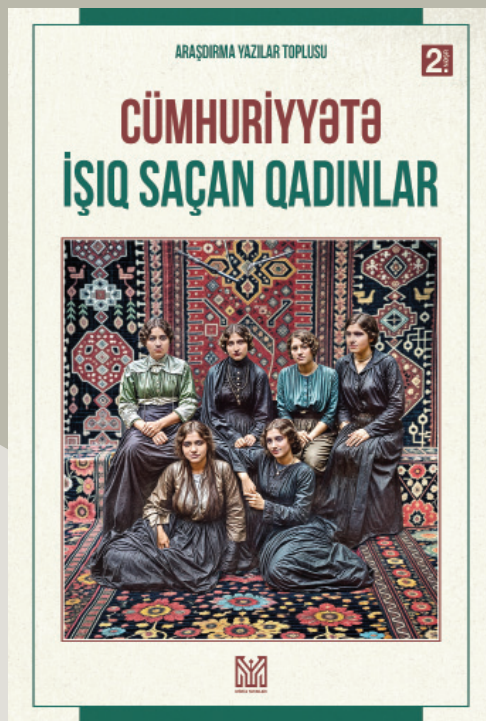


"Mirza Bala Mammadzade and the History of Azerbaijani Political Thought" AFGAN VALIYEV

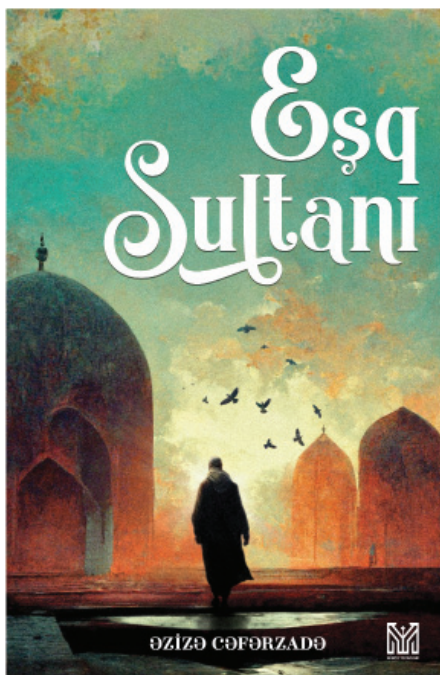
"Women who shed light on the Republic" Collection of research papers

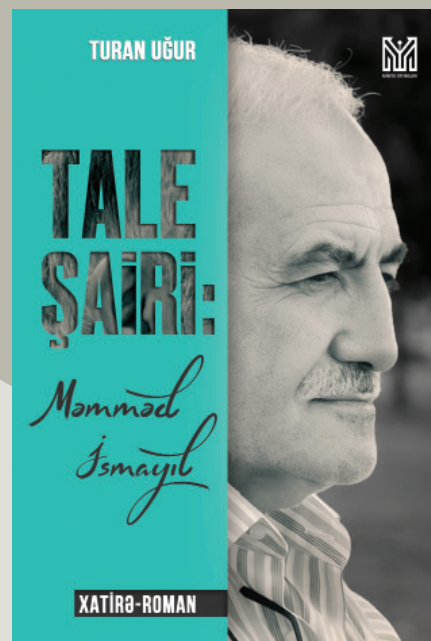


"Sultan of Love" AZIZA JAFARZADE
